It's hurtful to even have that accusation out there because I know how damaging that kind of talk can be, and I would never want to be part of something like that.

This whole situation has really taken a toll on me, especially at my young age, after having to let go of devs who I considered friends. It's been heavy on my heart, and it's honestly left me feeling pretty low. Losing people you care about and dealing with all of this negativity has been overwhelming.

Regarding the discord server, that was made years ago, I want to be clear, no pictures of minors were ever shared. Yes, it was a NSFW server, which in hindsight is really gross and inappropriate, but at the time I was literally just a bored 14 year old kid. I honestly don't even remember much about what happened in that server. It's something I'm deeply disgusted by now.

I apologized to Chowi for how I handled his mental health concerns, explaining that I misunderstood due to language barriers and thought he was lying because he asked for payment immediately after returning. I regret not being more empathetic and supportive during such a sensitive moment. I also apologized for being too harsh in my critiques of his work, admitting that I should have been more constructive rather than critical. I mentioned that I kept him on the team even during his four-month absence when he didn't have a computer, out of

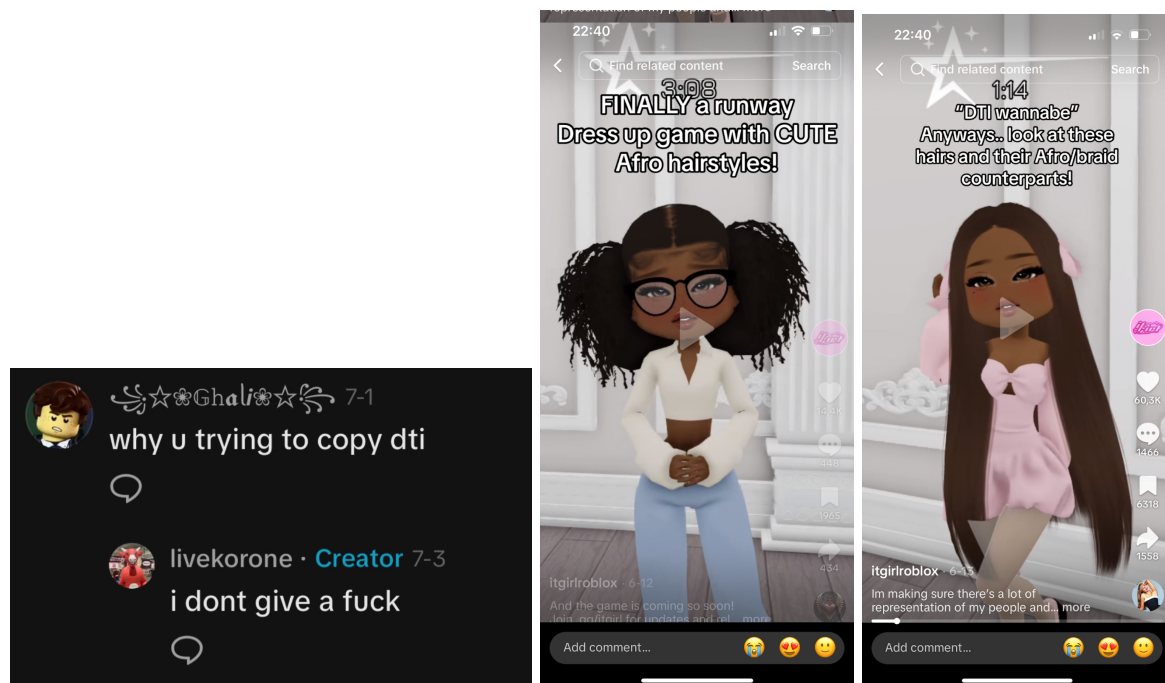
trust and respect. I also addressed the Dior bag situation. I never received the file and that the payment I made covered that scrapped item.

I am not in my 20s I am 17.

Because of everything that’s happened recently, I’ll be taking a lot of time to reflect on my actions and realize the harm that I’ve caused. I need space to process everything and focus on becoming a better version of myself. Thank you so much to those who’ve been understanding and supportive. It means a lot.

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I’d also like to say that half of these instances happened when I was 14. Which is no way an excuse, but they’re not recent. Also I’m lgbtq+ not homophobic. I’m shaking while typing this because things I did so young are coming back to haunt me.

I'm not racist. I have never exploited, I never doxxed anyone. I have never bought n*des from minors. It's an extremely sensitive topic for me and I hate that I have to bring it up again because it is traumatizing but when I was 14 me and a trusted friend sent each other images of each other. I was young and stupid but I never bought minors n*des.

I'd also like to speak up about how these messages were taken and spoken up about after I had to fire the two ex-devs. I understand how much I hurt you, but I wish you would've told me at that moment than to wait to have bad blood with me to tell me what I did wrong online.
