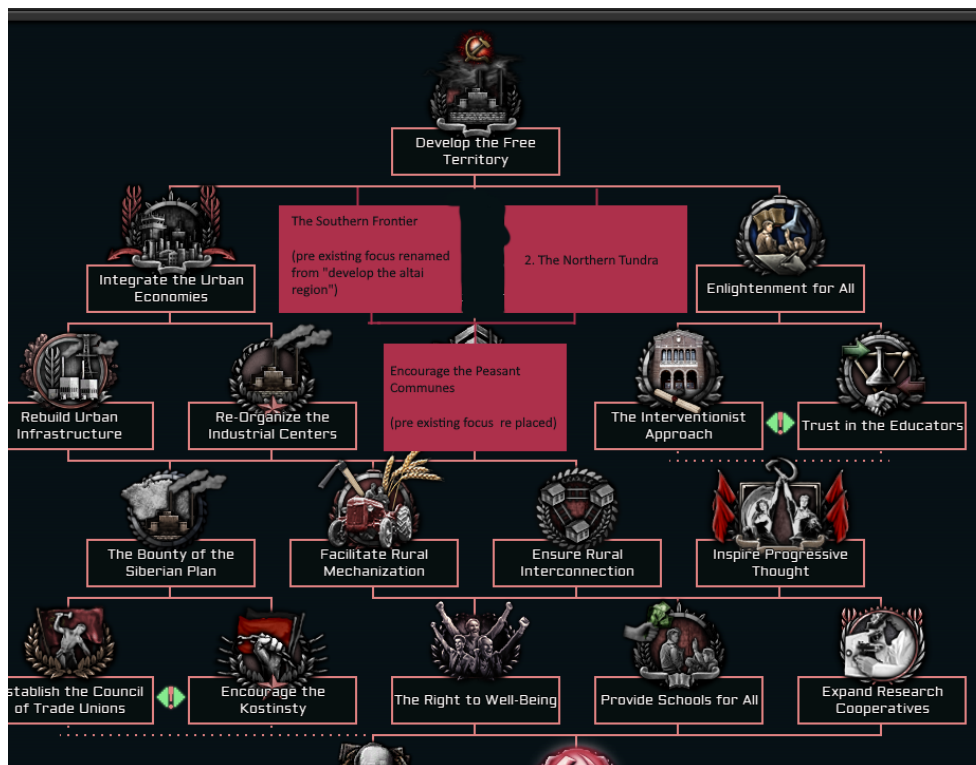

Minarchist Anarcho-Communism (Ideology changes if “Just the Bare Minimum” focus is taken

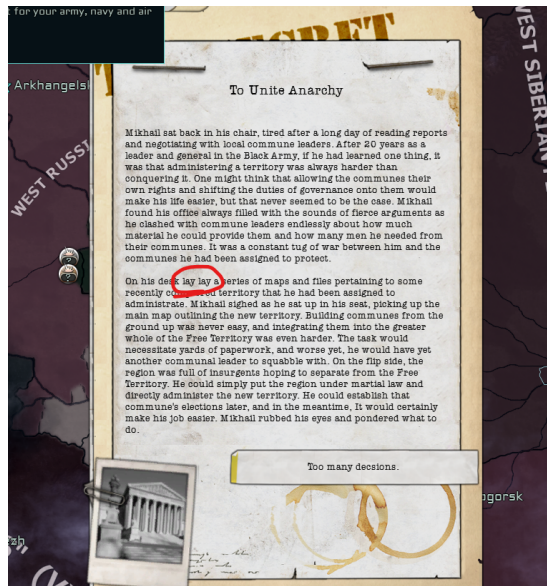
An inherently contradictory ideology to some, Minarchist Anarcho-Communism came to fruition following the success of the Siberian Black Army in Siberia, and the following coup attempt by elements of the Black Army. While traditional Anarcho-Communists advocate for the immediate abolition of all state structures, the adherents of Minarchist Anarcho-Communism argue that in the Post Smuta expanses of Russia, something to bind the communes together is unavoidable. The Philosophy calls for a skeletal administrative apparatus to handle only the most essential functions, while leaving legislative and judicial authority in the hands of the communes.

For a Free Territory that has been un-officially making its way towards this vision of anarchism for years, the believers of the ideology seek to legitimise it temporarily, as to ensure that it cannot expand any further than what Minarchist Anarcho-Communism itself is defined as. The bureaucracy is deliberately weak, highly decentralized, and designed to be temporary, serving as a framework that allows communes to cooperate with one another. Critics warn that even the smallest of administrative structures carry risk of the consolidation of power, and some fear that the temporary framework could evolve into a more permanent measure if let slide. Still, for many, Minarchist Anarcho-Communism is seen as the only viable path to freeing all Russians in such a turbulent environment, and only by maintaining the bare minimum can a truly stateless society thrive when the situation stabilises.

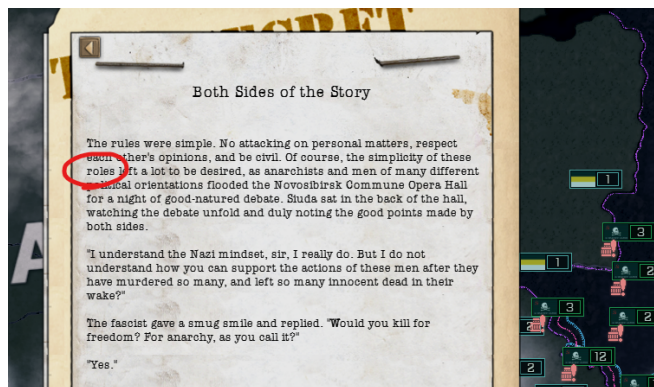

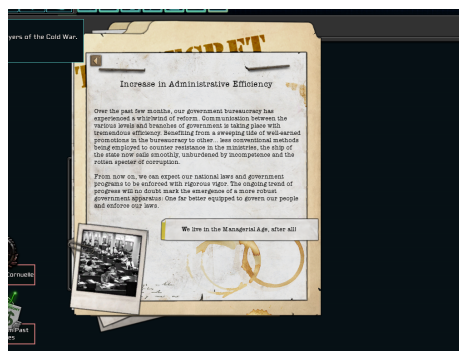
Bug central
