COUNT 1

On or about May 27, 2022, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of FIRST DEGREE RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 459, a Felony, was committed by JENNA SNOW, who did enter an inhabited dwelling house and trailer coach and inhabited portion of a building occupied by [REDACTED] with the intent to commit larceny and any felony.

"NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code section 1192.7(c)."

NOTICE: Upon a felony conviction for the above offense, prison custody time is to be served in state prison based upon the above felony offense being a serious felony defined in Penal Code section 1192.7 and/or violent felony defined in Penal Code section 667.5(c), or a felony offense requiring registration as sex offender pursuant to Penal Code section 290(c), within the meaning of Penal Code section 1170(h)(3).

It is further alleged that the above offense is a violation of Penal Code Section 462(a).

COUNT 2

On or about May 27, 2022, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of CRUELTY TO AN ANIMAL, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 597(a), a Felony, was committed by JENNA SNOW, who did unlawfully, maliciously and intentionally grabbed "[REDACTED]" by the leg and threw her to the ground.

COUNT 3

On or about May 27, 2022, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of VANDALISM \$400 OR MORE IN DAMAGE OR DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 594(a), a Felony, was committed by JENNA SNOW, who did unlawfully and maliciously damage and destroy real and personal property, to wit, LAPD Police vehicle not her, belonging to CITY OF LOS ANGELES.

It is further alleged that the amount of defacement, damage and destruction is four hundred dollars (\$400) or more, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 594(b)(1).

NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require the defendant to provide DNA samples and print impressions pursuant to Penal Code sections 296 and 296.1. Willful refusal to provide the samples and impressions is a crime.

NOTICE: The People of the State of California intend to present evidence and seek jury findings regarding all applicable circumstances in aggravation, pursuant to Penal Code section 1170(b) and *Cunningham v. California* (2007) 549 U.S. 270.

NOTICE: A Suspected Child Abuse Report (SCAR) may have been generated within the meaning of Penal Code §§ 11166 and 11168 involving the charges alleged in this complaint. Dissemination of a SCAR is limited by Penal Code §§ 11167 and 11167.5 and a court order is required for full disclosure of the contents of a SCAR.

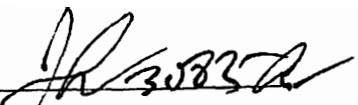
NOTICE: Any allegation making a defendant ineligible to serve a state prison sentence in the county jail shall not be subject to dismissal pursuant to Penal Code § 1385.

NOTICE: Conviction of this offense prohibits you from owning, purchasing, receiving, possessing, or having under your custody and control any firearms, and effective January 1, 2018, will require you to complete a Prohibited Persons Relinquishment Form ("PPR") pursuant to Penal Code § 29810.

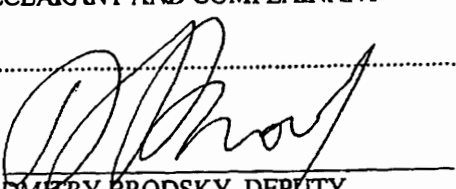
