On this the 10th day of November, 2016 the Defendant has been placed on community supervision for a period of 12 months for the above offense. **It is therefore ORDERED that the Defendant:**


- 1 [x] Commit no offense against the laws of this state or of any other state or the United States;
- 2 [x] Avoid injurious or vicious habits, do not use marijuana, narcotics, dangerous drugs, inhalants
- 2a[x] Do not use prescription medication without first obtaining a prescription for said substances from a licensed physician;
Provide proof of prescribed medication to you supervision officer;
- 3 [x] Avoid persons or places of disreputable or harmful character; and do not associate with individuals who commit offenses
Against the laws of this or any other State or the United States;
- 4 [x] Obey all rules and regulations of the Supervision Department, and report to the Supervision Officer as directed by the Judge or
Supervision Officer; to-wit: WEEKLY/TWICE MONTHLY/OR MONTHLY ON APPOINTED DATE/TIME
- 5 [x] Permit the community supervision officer to visit at defendant's home, place of employment or as required by the court; and notify the
Supervision Officer no less than twenty-four (24) hours prior to any changes in your home, employment address, email address and
phone number;
- 6 [x] Work faithfully at suitable employment as far as possible and seek the assistance of the Supervision Officer in your efforts
to secure employment when unemployed;
- 7 [x] Remain within a specified place, to wit [☒] Texas or [☐]
and do not travel outside Texas, without first having obtained permission from the Supervising Officer; provide proof of an
occupational driver's license if granted to your supervision officer for the purpose of resolving out of county driving privileges
- 8 [x] Support all dependents;
- 9 [x] Pay a supervisory fee of: **\$60.00** per month plus a \$2.00 transaction fee to the Supervision Officer on or before the first day of each
month hereafter during Supervision; money order, cashier's check or credit card online at www.payfeesnow.com
- 10[x] Perform 80 hours of community service as directed by your Supervision Officer or through; [☐] Road and Bridge; or [☒] Volunteer
Center and pay a \$55.00 fee for administrative duties required by the placement or as directed by the Supervision officer;
[☒] complete all hours 30 days PRIOR to probation expiration; ☒ 50% Cans (24cans = 1 hr OR \$8=1hr) NTFB;
OR [☐] community service waived for good cause shown
- 11[x] Report Immediately or within (5) five business days between 9:00am – 4:00pm to Misdemeanor Orientation, 133
N. Riverfront Blvd., 9th Floor, Dallas, TX 75207
- 12[x] Pay Court Costs, Fines, Court appointed attorney fees and Crime stoppers payable to the Collections Department ;
- 15[x] Within 180 days, participate in a **DWI Education Program**, and successfully complete the program, providing proof of completion to
your Supervision Officer
- 16[x] Participate in the Victim Impact Panel Program. Meetings are held at the Frank Crowley Building Central Jury Room, the 1st
Wednesday of each month from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Arrive at 6:15 to register; Cost is \$40.00 Bring a Money Order payable to
M.A.D.D.; No cash or checks are accepted.
- 17[x] Within 30 days from referral, participate in a Drug & Alcohol Evaluation, as offered by the Community Supervision and Corrections
Department or by an approved agency;
- 18 [x] Defendant must provide arresting officer with requested specimen if placed under arrest for DWI or any other offense under chapter 49
of the Texas Penal Code
- 19[x] Do not operate a motor vehicle unless it is equipped with an Ignition Interlock Device with camera approved by the Texas Department
of Public Safety. Provide proof of installation within 14days. Do not attempt to adjust, tamper with, or circumvent the Interlock
Device. Comply with all program requirements of the provider, including but not limited to submitting to testing at each unit request,
rolling retest, an abort reading, fail or violation reading before turning the ignition off and have no violations
The defendant will pay for the monthly lease and any other fees associated with the device as long as it is in their possession. The
Interlock Device calibration will be performed every thirty (30) days unless directed otherwise. The Interlock Device must be serviced
and cannot be in lockout. Do not obstruct or cover the camera. Dress appropriately for a picture to be taken.

The defendant is hereby advised that under the laws of this State, the Judge shall determine the terms and condition of defendant's community supervision, and may at any time during the period of community supervision alter or modify the condition of community supervision. The Judge also has the authority at any time during the period of community supervision to revoke the community supervision when a preponderance of the evidence establishes a violation of one or more of the conditions set for above.

The Supervision Officer of the said court furnished the defendant with a copy of the terms and conditions of community supervision.
