Elizabeth Hanes,

I hope you have been doing well your honor. Much has happened since I last wrote you, some 40 days into my stay here. As stated above I am now 171 days into my sentence. I could write out everything that has happened both to me as an individual and as a collective, but I don't want this letter to be lengthy. I want to get to the point, so in short it has been abysmal, to say the least.

I am writing you because I need your help. Please know that I would not be asking if I thought there was another way. Enclosed with this ~~letter~~ letter is my computation page given to me by the BoP.

I know I just said I would not be telling you the events that occurred here, but to understand the relevant details I have to fill you in on some of the context.

My case manager, Delarm, and my unit manager, Rogers, have so poorly handled my case that I am being held here 18 days, and counting, past the date I should have left. They have given me excuse after excuse, explanations that make no sense, dates that constantly change for the smallest reasons, Issues that suddenly emerge from nowhere, make mistakes where they should not, withhold critical information and in general are not trying to get me out of here. I show up to their open houses whenever I can to check on the status of my release/halfway house/RRC package and to see if there

Is anything I can do to help move things along and all I am told to do is just wait while they delay over and over. I have been fighting for them to just do the bare minimum their job requires since early September if not before that really. I had hopes of getting out of here until recently. My "SCA Recommended Placement Date" and my "Conditional Transition To Community Date" were once November 20th, 2025. My "SCA Recommended Placement Days" have remained unchanged at 180 days. What I did not know was that I was earning 15 FSA days per month which was continuously lowering my date of placement/transition. By the time you read this my date will likely have dropped another 15 days to October 11th, 2025 if not more. So given that I am already past October ~~11th~~ 26th there

is virtually no hope of me leaving on the 20th, 7 days from when I am writing this. So I am stuck in a strange limbo and purgatory state. Delarm still has not sent out the release package; the RRC, RRM and my probation officer have repeatedly said to my mother that until that goes through they can't do anything to help me. Even when the package goes out it can take the RRC 60 days to give me a date.

So why am I writing you and where do you come in? Well to my knowledge you can both send me to prison and release me from it. I am not totally well read on this subject, admittedly, but I believe you can file for my release or commutation of my sentence. I understand that this is an enormous request to make, but I

I beg of you to consider it. If nothing else for the sake of my mental stability as they continue to deny me of all of my medication and offer no therapy despite your orders and my best and repeated efforts to obtain both. In recent weeks I have felt myself slipping backwards even so slightly and cannot risk this to continue. I am doing my best but only so much is possible when you are deprived of sleep medicine and have serious insomnia. I will do whatever you ask of me. I am a man of oath and honor. I will not fail you. Send me to a halfway house or to ~~home~~ home confinement. Anywhere but prison. Let me show you I am a changed person.
